CONDITIONS

1. The Brighton Sprint Open Meet will be held under A.S.A. Laws & A.S.A. Technical Rules.
2. Competitors must be members of the club they represent.
3. As clubs are competing for a **Top Club Trophy** entries will only be accepted from swimmers in the name of their **individual clubs** not in the name of a **squad**.
4. It must be clearly understood that the competition is open to eligible competitors only and the completion of an entry will be taken by the promoters as an undertaking that the swimmer is a bona fide eligible competitor.
5. All entries must be by Email
6. **CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES 4th September 2010**
7. **AGES AS AT 18TH SEPTEMBER 2010**
8. All events will be **HEAT DECLARED WINNER**. If times and heat places are identical a swim off may be held to determine top six places.
9. The pool is 25 metres. Times are required for all 50 metre events for the purpose of seeding.
10. **Sign OUT will close at 8.45am 1st session and 13.30pm 2nd Session.**
11. Competitors must report as called. It is a swimmers responsibility to report when called.
12. Awards will be given to the fastest 6 in each age group who complete the race without disqualification. The decision of the referee is final.
13. **TOP CLUB TROPHY** -.Points from top six places
14. Swimmers are not permitted in the spectator area or the foyer in swimsuits.
15. Entry fees must be sent with entry form
16. A single club Cheque to be made payable to "**BRIGHTON SWIMMING CLUB**" No cash accepted.
17. No entries will be accepted on the day
18. A.S.A. Law permits a competitor to start a race in the water, from the side or from a starting block. Only persons trained to do the competitive start from starting blocks into shallow water should do so. Get clearance from your coach/teacher.
19. **DO NOT USE THE STARTING BLOCKS AT THE SHALLOW END OF THE POOL DURING WARM UP.**
20. **SECURITY:** Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither Brighton Swimming Club or the Prince Regent Complex management can be held responsible for lost property. It is recommended that all swimmers use pool lockers.
21. Matters not covered by these conditions or which arise during the meet shall be determined by **BRIGHTON SWIMMING CLUB** whose decision shall be final.
